Tanja Playner

Austria

Born in USSR and living in Austria, artist Tanja Playner shares optimism and zest for life with her strikingly colorful unique works of art. With her works of art, the artist communicates with people in order to make modern society a little better. She has managed to thrill millions of people with her art. On Twitter follow the artist about 500,000 followers, on facebook about 1,000,000 fans, as also many thousands followers on instagram worldwide. In social media, the artist reaches more than 15 million people a month with her art.

Critics compared her to a mix of Andy Warhol, Roy Lichtenstein and Strokes by Picasso. The British Vogue publishes the artwork "Mona Lisa" by Tanja Playner under Vogue's Masterpiece ... and GQ Magazine publishes the work "Sweet Whisper" in November 2015 alongside Daniel Craig & Monica Belucci and Photograph Ranking with her ranking among the top 300 artists worldwide on artnet. In April 2016 Tanja Playner was listed in the Top 5 Twitter Kings in the Media Magazine in 2nd place. In January 2019 she was listed under the Top internet stars of Austria in one of the biggest newspaper in Austria "Österreich".

Tanja Playner also deals with modern objects, consumer products and people's emotions. She speaks in her art about the way of our society and touches the hearts of the beholder with colorful colors in conjunction with positive emotions. Her motives are not sad emotions, and they are the opposite of cartoons.

Since 2018 Tanja Playner has been experimenting with body plasticity, space and the human sense of self in relation to objects and space. In combination with her already developed style, the artworks often show controversial depictions of the human body to reality.

In contrast to the artist Georg Baselitz, who mainly turns the human body upside down, Tanja Playner places the human body perpendicular to objects. Split upper bodies and lower bodies can often be seen on the artworks, placed perpendicularly, parallel or transversely to one another.

The often split upper and lower bodies are not only placed perpendicularly, parallel or transversely to each other, but also to the landscapes, still lifes and objects. Often the images are presented in combination with abstract, intricate wavy lines that minimize abstract depiction.

The artist's experimental curiosity has continually evolved over the years. In many of her works, she distributes body parts. Tanja Playner develops a new visual language with her fluctuating body parts, bringing them into a new reality. Despite their modern representation, her works appear elegant. The artworks hover between harmony and madness.

With the conspicuousness of her pop art motifs, she reached number 11 in the July 2017 ranking of the top 300 artists worldwide on artnet and stood in front of Damien Hirst, Fernando Botero, Gerhard Richter, Jeff Koons, Yayoi Kusama, Alex Katz, Mr. Brainwash, Takashi Murakami. The artworks of Tanja Playner have been featured in over 50 international exhibitions such as the Antoni Gaudi Modernist Museum in Barcelona, as far as Carrousel du Louvre Paris during the FIAC Art Week 2014 - 2019, Art Basel Miami Art Week 2015, Art Basel Art Week 2019 at the Art Biennale Basel, shown during Cannes Film Festival 2015 - 2019 and Quest Hall Harajuku in Tokyo. The grandson of Ferdinand Porsche Ernst Piech has shown 50 large-format works of Tanja Playner in his museum "FahrTraum" and and also he has art of Tanja Playner in his collection. Also the actress Ornella Muti has the artwork of Tanja Playner in her own.

Tanja Playner is one of the few artists worldwide who was dedicated her own art museum at the age of 32.



Rebeccah Klodt is an abstract expressionist from the Twin Cities area of Minnesota, USA. Her art is on display throughout the United States and Europe. She works out of her Minneapolis studio overlooking the Mississippi River, and her lake home as well. Nature, music, and life's majesty are key inspirations for her.

Rebeccah's belief is that the viewer's interpretation of her art is paramount to giving her art meaning. All of her art is untitled to avoid influencing a viewer's response to each painting. Rebeccah enjoys hearing the titles and nicknames people come up with to refer to specific pieces. Leaving the work untitled asks the viewer to engage with her work more deeply and invites them to take part in the artistic process.

Rebeccah is always finding inspiration for new collections while also developing her Soul Work and Line Work. There are no limits for the potential themes, mediums, and materials she may experiment with in the future. Just recently she worked with a sixty-foot canvas roll working with natural elements such as rain, wind, trees, earth, and gravity painting techniques. Art is Rebeccah's favorite mode of expression and she feels that it is an honor to continue to share with the world for years to come.

Stephen Najda

United Kingdom

The art of Stephen Najda crosses many boundaries, over a wide spectrum of subjects, and a multitude of techniques. A complex individual with a deep curiosity and an extraordinary fertile mind that crosses a huge range of subjects that coalesce into art in an attempt to articulate the known fundamental interactions of the universe and forms of matter. Often called Renaissance man, Najda is a precociously talented and prolific artist bringing a multidisciplinary background in science, literature and art, mixed with an insatiable appetite for adventure and travel. Stylistically placed between Matisse, Picasso and de Kooning, Najda features expressionistic figures representing the primitive self in big, bold, hugely imaginative paintings.

The PAKS Gallery is proud to present Najda's expressive nudes. Painting the human form is the most difficult of all art forms. Najda's early style was technical fleshy nudes and self-portraits, however his style transformed dramatically into dramatic, contemplative figures visually skewed and exaggerated, with bold curvaceous lines melting into a chaotic burst of colour and vivid primary pigment Fauve flesh. Each work brings a new openness and ambiguity and shifts back and forth between representation and abstraction. For Najda this change was instinctive giving a progressive and yet accessible style.

While stars like Catherine Zeta-Jones, Michael Douglas and Julianne Moore as well as Harrison Ford and Brad Pitt caused a stir on the red carpet at the Cannes Film Festival, Stephen Najda's work was also at the Fine Art Cannes Biennale 2022 and the Contemporary Art Cannes Biennale to be seen in 2023. Stephen Najda is one of the artists who aroused interest in himself and his art during the Cannes Film Festival, like artists such as Picasso and Salvador Dali, who also attracted attention during this time in Cannes.

His art was also exhibited at the Contemporary and Fine Art Biennale Basel during Art Basel Week 2022. In Paris, close to the great masters, Naida's works were exhibited at the Carrousel du Louvre in October 2023.

Sandra Sherrington was born in Lausanne, Switzerland.

In 1996 she discovered clay and was immediately seduced by this material and the endless possibilities for creation it offered her. She never stopped modelling and sculpting it to develop her personal technique for a perfect finish to her creations.

Sandra Sherrington likes to capture movements and expressions to create life in her characters.

Each of her sculptures reflects a piece of her personality, not forgetting her enthusiasm and passion for life.

All of her creations are unique and come from her boundless imagination. She also gladly executes personalised pieces according to your desires! Her first exhibition took place at the 2003 Montreux Art Gallery (MAG), in Switzerland, then others followed in Lausanne and the surrounding area. Later, she exhibited in Thailand and France, countries she lived in for a few years.

She returned to Switzerland in 2009 and created several workshop-galleries.

Today in her workshop-gallery ARTIS Art & Decoration in Yverdon-les-Bains, Switzerland, Sandra Sherrington creates her sculptures, her paintings, exhibits them and organises creative workshops.

Nasim

Germany

At the age 6, Nasim was adopted from a Kazakh Orphanage to Hamburg Germany under the adoptive name Natalia Blatz. She now publishes her art under her birth name NASIM.

The artist draws a lot of muse from her path of finding her own identity. Nasim claims that ever since she's been a little girl she sees the world through colors. Along with socially reflective statements and loud colors, her art aims to create a sense of sensuality and excitement.

In her artwork she uses many different layers, each using different techniques and sometimes materials. Nasim has been painting abstract since 2016 and then found herself in a modern realistic style from 2022. She prefers to express herself on large canvas and uses acrylic, neon acrylic and spray paint.

Nasim's abstract works of art bear the influence of Gerhard Richter's techniques. The colors are applied in layers and set in motion with a palette knife. However, in several works the artist goes her own way and experiments with movement.

At times these are reminiscent of geometric objects and at other times they create a certain dialogue with the works of Rothko. The artist also incorporates expressions into her work. Lines are used. In connection with the background and the color scheme of the lines, the work is reminiscent of the forest with its depth. It is like a web, the contrast of the colors that the artist uses. Red and blue lines create a strong contrast and a dialogue in the search for questions and answers. The lines, which in a certain way symbolically recall the cross and the sun at the same time, can also be found in the work "Marta." This work is kept in subtle and sensitive colors. In her work "Lili Grab," the artist uses colors that reflect her closeness to nature. Earthy tones are overlaid with sky blue. A contrasting red color suddenly appears, adding an accent to the artwork. Experimentation accompanies NASIM in her work and is the driving force in the creation of her works of art.

Light, which was important to Claude Monet's art, also accompanies Marianne Dencausse's work. Even when she uses darker, contrasting colors, we sense the luminous accents when viewing them. Despite the modern depiction of the motifs, her artworks exude a romantic touch. In some works, buildings are only hinted at, similar to the way Nicolas de Staël painted them. In many of the works, the use of light plays a very significant role. This gives many works of art a fairytale-like, almost sacred atmosphere.

Marianne Dencausse combines several approaches from art history and experiments with these techniques. Her paintings are impressive, expressive, and at the same time very sensitive.

The joyful palettes the artist uses and her perspective on the chosen motif reveal her perspective on art. In many of her works, the artist brings movement into the work. Even when depicting flowers, you can feel the wind stirring the leaves; when depicting a regatta, you can feel the wind guiding the sea and the boat. A masterful selection of colors brings the mood to life. Whether it's the calm of the sea, a gentle breeze, or rain, Marianne Dencausse brings it to life in her artwork.

Her works do not pose any critical questions, they are free of profound philosophical interpretations and explanations, but they are full of emotions, mostly positive emotions, and the works also evoke positive emotions when viewed.

Jiří Máška was born in 1951 in Ražice, a small town in South Bohemia, Czech Republic. He has been an artist since his early childhood. His grandfather noticed Jiří's talent and arranged for him to meet a friend of his, painter Říhánek. Říhánek taught Jiří the fundamentals of composition and colours, artistic sense, and the perception of art as a whole. Jiří's mother supported her son's work, buying him the best paints, brushes, and other art supplies. Říhánek stayed with his student until Jiří was 10. At that time, Jiří began to take painting classes with another painter, Jiří Rejžek, in the town of Strakonice. Rejžek taught Jiří until he was16, and then he supported Jiří's application to the Arts school in Prague.

At the Arts school, Máška studied under Professor Janoch. After graduation in Prague, Máška returned to South Bohemia where he worked as Head of Promotion at the Park of Culture and Relaxation in České Budějovice.

Máška and several of his friends who were painters and sculptors, created an art group. They displayed art that was unacceptable by the Communist regime—the ruling government of the time. The Communist authorities closed down the group's exhibition in 1983, which they followed by police harassment. This meant denying Máška the chance for publicity, because he could not display his art, and this also hampered his artistic development. In order to live, Máška needed to paint and express himself freely, so he left the country and immigrated to the United States. There he studied painting with Professor Hanson at Everett College in Washington.

Upon finishing his studies with Professor Hansen, Máška displayed his paintings in the Jackson Street Gallery in Seattle, Washington. The reaction to the exhibition was unambiguous, both by the public and critics—right away, Máška was offered to exhibit in New York.

After his exhibition in New York in the Ariel Gallery, a prestigious New York art magazine, Manhattan Arts, ran a full page feature on Máška.

Marc Noël

Belgium

Writing a complete biography to describe a being like Marc Noël is very simple: "A man beyond all norms".

That's it, you have a complete biography of Marc Noël!

And yes, to describe a man like Marc Noël, this first paragraph said it all, but, the human being needs "more explanations", depending on the size of his ego. The ego must hear, understand, see, be able to touch, analyze, and judge... The ego needs to be able to put into boxes and compartments what makes sense in his perception of reality, in order to be able to connect with his logic...

The ego needs to be able to identify what he observes and compare it with everything that has been programmed into his brain and even into his cellular information... The ego has the need to be able to discuss and debate about "the reason" and to be able to give a certain logic and reality to the thing that is being presented to him...

Through whom he is, Marc Noël's mission has always been to share something completely different in this world, from different viewpoints and in different forms, but complementary to what the ego's perception of reality is. In all his forms, and here in this biography more specifically as an artist painter, Marc Noël has the desire and the need to share with the world through his artistic creations something that is completely "out of the norm", but where nevertheless the person who permits himself, and who dares to enter into the artistic creations presented by Marc Noël, will have the opportunity to discover another dimension.

How has he succeeded in developing this quality as an artist painter? This is a long story and at the same time, it is so recent...

When he was young, he had a major car accident which shifted his life overnight into a completely different dimension from what he had planned to live during this incarnation... And it was there that he began his training "at the Academy of Fine Arts of the Universe"... Through a long path of rehabilitation, specifically at the level of anything related to fine motor skills (i.e., hand rehabilitation related to cerebral commands), the universe put him in contact with an exceptional therapist who dared to take on the challenge of guiding Marc Noël in this hand rehabilitation. This therapist with very high skills, patience, and wisdom understood very quickly that the patient he had in front of him was not a "standard" patient, and thus, this professional has been able to go outside of all his classic rehabilitation techniques with his patient.

Together they completed a magnificent therapeutic path, which allowed Marc Noël to, first, gain the ability to hold a pencil again between his fingers, through which the first achievements were the drawing of completely closed circles. Through his motivation, his determination, his need to evolve, and his way of self-teaching, day after day, week after week, month after month, year after year, Marc Noël went through drawing, pastels, Japanese calligraphy, and painting to finally completely recover the control over his hands!

But as in everything he does in life, he always has the need to look further "outside the box", and there, he discovered that all this artistic creation was still limited by a certain "technique, and reason, and logic"...

He felt at a certain moment that everything was so small and limited in his artistic expression...

Through a whole evolution that followed both on a personal and professional level, a mystical opportunity also came his way. According to the dictionary, the word "mystical" is defined as "predisposed to mysticism, to an intense and intuitive faith." He began to make his first paintings, which were no longer only guided by a mastery of the hand with a brush on a canvas, but also through guidance from another dimension which passed through the hand, through the brush on the canvas... and THIS IS WHERE THE QUANTUM PAINTING THAT HE IS CREATING TODAY IS BORN!

The paintings he creates today are not just paintings but are very powerful evolving tools which, through time and the observer who stands in front of them, will create an opportunity for an "out of the norm" encounter between the quantum painting and the observer. These are now quantum paintings that change every day for the observer, even though the painting is not modified physically, because the quantum painting adapts itself in what it shows according to the evolution of the observer...

His objective as an artist painter here is not to go against the classical art of painting, which is often limited by a great rigidity and rigor of technique, norms, and social critics, whereby a painting must adhere to a whole list of criteria to be recognized by "the standard".

What he brings through his quantum painting is complementary to this classical artistic world, which means, giving art through painting an additional dimension, but also give him the opportunity to develop "this freedom of artistic creation"!





In Friedman's work, emergent reimagination defies gravity, bending the laws of space and time in order to question prevailing binaries in society: reason/nature, male/female, guilty/innocent, good/evil.

Tyche – The Mirror of the Fortune Bearer

"This painting is born from life's circumstances—moments of trials, transformation, and resilience. Drawn to the name Tyche, the Greek goddess of fortune, I found inspiration in her symbolism, yet I see her not as a distant deity but as a reflection of the self. She embodies the power within each of us to shape our destiny, to rise above challenges, and to create our own fortune.

In this artwork, Tyche emerges radiant against stormy skies, a beacon of hope amidst dark, rainy clouds. She rises from the depths of the blue, carried by her white horse—a symbol of purity, wisdom, and unstoppable determination. Her presence signifies resilience, a soul that refuses to be consumed by despair.

This piece carries a deeply personal message. I have learned that the lowest points in life are not mere obstacles but opportunities—times when we are forced to mend our minds and souls. Though the process is difficult, it is within these very struggles that we discover the key to our own ascension.

Once you embrace this truth, you rise—like an Indian crowned queen who has walked through fire and emerged with wisdom. Born in 1978 in Changchun, Jilin Province, China, she moved to Shanghai in 2004.

Yu Qian's artistic career reveals a trajectory of deep exploration into abstract language. After completing her foundational training at the Jilin College of Art, she chose to make specialized breakthroughs at three top art institutions—the oil painting research program at the China Academy of Art deepened her understanding of material expressiveness, the abstract courses at the Central Academy of Fine Arts deconstructed formal logic, and the watercolor studies at the Shanghai Artists Association expanded the boundaries of media. This stepwise academic path shaped her multidimensional creative vision.

The artist transforms auditory synaesthesia into visual rhythm. Music provides not only an inspiration trigger but also forms an invisible set of creative rules—the jumping color blocks in the picture are like chord collisions, and the wandering lines subtly correspond to rhythmic fluctuations. She deliberately preserves the accidental texture when acrylic and oil colors blend, and this "unfinished feeling" appropriately reflects the aesthetics of dynamic balance in nature.

Her color system holds semiotic significance; the strong contrasting colors are not just visual tension but also metaphors for the philosophical dialogue between reason and emotion.

They guide viewers to complete self-projection amidst the interplay of presence and absence, creating a multidimensional spatial illusion on a two-dimensional plane.

The reason her works resonate across cultures is rooted in the artist's capture of primal vitality. The naturally cracked, net-like structures formed by thick layers of paint subtly align with the natural patterns of mountains and rivers or cellular fission. This creative thinking, which merges microscopic and macroscopic perspectives, makes her abstract language both contemporary and a continuation of the Eastern aesthetic genealogy.

Van Gogh discovered sunflowers for himself and associated them with his name in paintings around the world. Alex Klas is also touched by sunflowers and interprets them in his works in different ways: sometimes delicate and fragile and sometimes a little spicy combined with pepperoni. He shows how the artist can still convey the joy of modern painting in his works today, despite the classical perspective.

In terms of animals' expressions, they are usually peaceful or amusing. I want people to feel their purity. For the colour of animal fur, I consider the difference between reality and painting. I refer to the real colours, but I do not be limited, because it is still necessary to consider people's feelings that the colours represent on the capyar

Some backgrounds are composed of colour blocks. It is to make the space where the animals stay distance from reality and make it like another world or a dream.

The background of the dyeing effect is like a stream of flowing light. The purpose is to show the gentle calmness through the rippling light and shadow.

As for the soft-coloured method of processing the background, I let the animals be in a very pink world, where there are only peace and beauty".

After completion of vocational school education, Horst Lukas studied and completed landscape architecture at the Comprehensive University of Kassel from 1986 to 1993 with a diploma degree. Work as a landscape architect since 1993, since 2001 self-employed.

For over thirty years the medium of painting has been Horst Lukas' artistic expression of choice. Beginning as a self-taught painter, intense studies of painting technique and expression followed in Kassel as a guest student at the School of Fine Arts (Hochschule der Bildenden Künste) with Professor Hennings, among others. In the following years he participated in various painting workshops, i.e. in Tuscany, Italy to further training in figurative expression.

First experiences in painting were sought in surrealism, with painters such as Dali and Magritte serving as pioneer role models. The paintings in this period were strongly influenced by societal criticism, the topics often visualized in the works of art. Following this period was a short naturalistic phase with landscape motifs.

From the time of his studies at the School of Fine Arts and onward, Lukas' focus in oil painting moved to abstract non-representational expression.

His frequent experimentation with painting technique up to completion of a painting in this period resulted in an individual style of oil painting based on a special technique of paint application with palette-knife and brush. The interplay of colors increasingly rises to the fore ground. Many works from the following period until today are defined by this oil paint method, denoting abstraction in the painting. Even where his subjects take on a concerted figurative approach, the imaginary space of abstraction persists and takes on a prominent space within his work.

"Color and matter are in a special interaction in Horst Lukas`artworks, one and the other are inseparable and together form a winning pair: If you look closely at the artworks, you immediately notice the contrast between the smoothness of certain parts, of the surface an the rippling materiality, especially in the places where longnes and masses of color meet or simply meet in a delicate embrace. These contrasts, rhythmic and tonal, are the essence of Lukas`style and make his works distinctive." Luca Francil / Udine, Italy



Common to all my visual work is the use of strong colours, which enhance my message and the practice of soulful feminism and womanhood, which has no political implications – serves the reclamation of the soul instead, as mentioned before.

I believe that art reflects truths, humans are sometimes too afraid to speak out using their voices.

The visual and literary tool of expression is one of the most powerful tools available that's why I have fallen in deep love with Art herself and use her for the personal articulation of truths and wisdom I can tap into.


Through my paintings and literary work, I intend to be a voice in the world and the metaphysical realm to which we all need to learn how to gain access. Such access is possible through art, I believe.

'Fontana Shelter' (an Opulent Art Gallery represented artist and a member of Saatchi Art based in London/Los Angeles, West Ox Arts Gallery in Bampton, Oxfordshire Artweeks in Oxford, JaamZIN Creative Studio in Singapore, Parallax Art Fair in London, Mart Gallery Studios in Dublin and West Norfolk Artists Association in King's Lynn) carries on with the art activity of the Italian painter Luigi Fontana.

Born in Piacenza, the son of a decorator and nephew of a paintress who gave him an artistic education, at first Luigi Fontana became a portraitist and his work was marked by a great vitality and rich tempera colours, taste and elegance. After he gave himself entirely over to the landscape, a keen microcosm of man's soul. He was particularly impressed by some majestic monuments of cities he visited and which he painted several times (pyrography on wood).

Fontana Shelter's activity was recently created in his loving memory. Moreover the hand of fate has played a decisive role because it 'caused' the lucky rendez-vous with the stunning Downton Abbey TV drama series and then with West Ox Arts Gallery in Bampton (the exquisite real location of Downton Village). Finally Covid-19 Pandemic had a fundamental influence on the artist's way of thinking and the terrible

lockdown made FS understand the importance of art as a promotional means of moral virtues. As a matter of fact, the art name SHELTER embodies the romantic and sentimental meaning of this word: a place or something giving PROTECTION from danger. In a nutshell, this activity is a shelter and a real place of Truth and Happiness.

Fontana Shelter is proudly supported by cultural website DOWNTON GAZETTE (downtongazette.altervista.org), recently created just after the Covid-19 Pandemic in order to promote the beauty through art, music, theatre and literature and concerning whatever can be referred to Downton Abbey TV drama series. Thus it's full of photographs of the enchanting and exquisite DA locations in Oxfordshire (Bampton, Shilton, Swinbrook and Cogges) and Highclere Castle and Estate. You can also find lots of mesmerizing articles celebrating UK art exhibitions, shows and celebrities.

Also featuring on OX LOVES and MainlyMuseums.com, Downton Gazette's leader is a member of Friends of Highclere and The Shaw Society

Well, you know, Fontana's pictures always become the awesome illustrations of Downton Gazette's books ('SHINING OCEAN' published in 2023 and 'GUIDING LIGHT:SIR BUSBY. FEAT. MR BATES' in 2024) and are joyfully accompanied with the lyrics of moving and touching songs. In fact their art is based on circular connections and aims to tell a story like a movie's script. I'll try to explain it in a nutshell: to prepare an advert about Downton Gazette on ITVX ANGLIA , they used Fontana Shelter's paintings to describe each scene in the storyline like a screen grab that represents what's being said in the script.

He explores the relationships between all arts and creates interactions between them. For this reason, he founded "The Body Magic Group" in Iran in 2012 and continues to lead it today.

Together they founded The Body Magic Group Switzerland in 2023.

Artist relationship Romaine Kuonen and Hadi MohammadKhani:


Since 2020 they have been working closely together in various areas of painting as well as physical theater and performances, sharing the same intention towards art and expression.

Their specialty is exhibiting collaboratively created paintings and combining them with performance. They are personally present at various international exhibitions with their joint artworks and digital competitions.

They began in 2022/2023 with the successful exhibition of joint works in Bern and Zurich in Switzerland, in Milan, Rome, Florence, Venice in Italy and in 2024 in Zurich, Zug and Paris at the Circle of the Louvre. In 2023 they received the first international Donatello Prize in Florence and in 2024 the Botticelli Prize from the Effeto Arte Foundation Italy.

In June/July 2024, they were invited to a month-long artist-in-residence project in China/Chengdu by NY20+ Nongyuan Culture, one of the main sponsors of the Arte Laguna Prize. In May 2024, their collaborative paintings inspired by old Italian masters were exhibited for a month in Beijing/CN at the Pashmin Art Archive Museum and in October 2024 they will also be presented at the Pashmin Art Gallery in Chongjing/CN.

They are convinced that the future will be redefined through the professional exchange of different art disciplines. Art builds bridges, connects people and stands against apartheid and wars.




Forgiveness 2025 100 x 80 cm Mixed technique

May-May Meijer (1972) is a mother of a grown-up son. She gained her PhD in Communication Science at the Vrije Universiteit in Amsterdam. After her graduation, May-May was working as assistant professor for the working group on Philanthropy at the Vrije Universiteit when she experienced a psychosis for the first time in her life. Her world fell apart when she was forcibly admitted to a mental hospital, where she was diagnosed with schizophrenia. Nevertheless, she recovered with the help of her family, fellow patients, the doctors, nurses, and with God's help. Christ encouraged May-May to write the book Here I Am. This is the sequel to her book Inner Voices. May-May gives guest lectures at various universities about her mental vulnerability and meeting with God. In 2015 she founded the peace organization Peace SOS.

God inspires May-May to this day to tell her story and promote world peace via her peace organization and her art.

May-May often sees what she calls 'God's Light'. She takes photos of it or asks others to photograph her accompanied by the light. May-May's photos can be categorized as art brut or contemporary sacred art. Her photos were exhibited amongst others at the Fine Art Cannes Biennale, the Shanghai International Art Fair, The Biennale of Contemporary Sacred Art in France, the Zamca art gallery in Romania, the Saint Vitus Church in the Netherlands and the International Art Brut Biennale in the Netherlands.

Critics qualify Gala Moskvitina's Art of the Heart as Laternative Realism (derived from Latin words "light" and "nature"). Laternative Realism belongs to Objective Art, defined by a famous philosopher George Gurdjieff in the last century. Objective Art works with the highest, universal tasks that have ever been tackled by humanity. It deals with consciousness, soul, spirit and heart. It is concerned with peace, eternity, immortality, happiness and love.

Gala invented Laternative Realism, she is the only artist in the world who works in this style and there is good reason behind it. She won public acclaim as a graphic artist and book illustrator early in life. Nearly 70 books were published with her illustrations including the complete works of W. Shakespeare and other titles of world classics. But one day she left her glittering career, family and city life and went to the East for 15 long years. There, in distant monasteries of China and ashrams of India, Gala inquired into spiritual meaning of life, her real higher awareness and true power.

Recently she reappeared at the art scene in a different capacity. Now she lavishly shares with the viewers her spiritual findings and discoveries through her artistic works called Lightanghs (the word is derived from «light» and «anchor»). These paintings are peculiar anchors of the soul's light on Earth. Moskvitina's Laternative Realism is dedicated to the inquest of such concepts as Light, Luminance and Luminescence.

Spiritual transformation attained by Gala in the monasteries of the East revealed to her, that the light that people see is only a reflection of the true spiritual Light, of which the whole Universe and all of us are made. And the best thing that can ever happen to a living being is a union with the real life-giving source, the infinite light of awareness.

Moskvitina's paintings have been sold at the biggest auctions of the world, such as Bonhams and MacDougalls. Many are now in private collections, sometimes as meditative pieces. Her art inspires people to uplift their own soul and spirit. In the presence of Gala's Lightanghs a viewer can experience his own light, feel the voice of his own consciousness, understand the power of his own heart. Very few persons in the world have spiritual experiences similar to Gala's, and even fewer of them agree to openly speak about it.

Gala's Laternative Realism is a gift to those who want to develop their potential abilities, contact their true power, and find real love and fullness of being. Her work is not just a harmony of colors created by an artist's masterful hand, but a message of Light, a true Art of the Heart.
